#### GOSPEL REFLECTION

In today's Gospel (Matt.21: 28-32), a man had two sons and he asked them both to go out and work in the vineyard. The first son said he would not go. He later changed his mind and went as his father had asked him. The second son said he would go but didn't. Jesus asks a question about this story. Which one of the two sons did what his father asked him to do?

The man in the story is God. And we are all God's children. So Jesus is trying to tell us that we should listen to what God asks of us and then go and do what is asked. It is not enough just to say that we will follow God in our lives. We actually have to go and do what we say we will do. We have to live our lives as God wants us to. God asks us to take care of the world and the people in it and it is up to us as to how we answer.

We are invited by Jesus to recognise the continuous presence of God in our lives. Through His earthly ministry He has shown us the path to follow.

Our daily lives often pull us all over the place and distract us from our promises and good intentions but today's Gospel is reminding us that when we say yes to God's call, we must be prepared to continue honouring that promise throughout our lives. God is our Master and we are merely guests in His vineyard.
