### SAINT OF THE WEEK – ST. COLUMBAN.

St. Columban (*Columbanus*), Abbot and Missionary was born in Leinster about 543.

A monk and teacher at Bangor until middle aged when he left with twelve companions as "exiles for Christ" to found monasteries in Burgundy in France. He maintained strict Celtic customs and usages, was expelled for denouncing royal misconduct but went on to extend the Irish mission through the Alps and into Italy where he established a monastery at Bobbio, near Genoa where he died in 615.

Noted for his austerity of life, his missionary energy, and his role in the development of individual reconciliation. He is remembered as one of the greatest of the Irish missionary monks. His feast day is celebrated on [23<sup>rd</sup> Nov.](#)
