SAINT OF THE WEEK - ST. CAILLIN.

St. Caillin was born in Galway in the 6th century and founded a famous monastic settlement at Fenagh. Before coming to Fenagh, he had a long course of study in Ireland and his first tutor was St. Fintan. To complete his studies, he went to Rome and for this journey it is said that St. Fintan gave him 300 ounces of gold. At the end of a long period of study in Rome, Caillin returned to Ireland and he brought with him relics of the twelve apostles and the neck-cloth of the infant Jesus. St. Caillin's mortal remains are in a vault attached to the wall (south) of the Abbey and here rests Fenagh's most famous son. His Feast day is celebrated on 13th Nov.
