#### GAUDETE SUNDAY

JOHN 1:6-8 & 19-28

Today is called Gaudete Sunday. The word 'Gaudete' means rejoice.

We rejoice on reaching the mid-point of Advent and that
our waiting will soon be over. On the Advent Wreath, the candle of
joy which is rose or pink coloured is lit. The change in colour
provides us with encouragement to continue our spiritual preparation—
especially prayer and fasting—for Christmas. Today reminds us that
God who loves us is still in charge and that we await his coming
not with fear, but with tremendous joy.

In today's Gospel, we hear about the prophet John the Baptist explaining that he is not the light but that he has come to tell about the light which of course is Jesus who is the light of the world.

Jesus is the Son of God and he shows us how we should live—he is a shining light in the darkness for us to follow.

The Jews and others who were sent by the Pharisees, questioned John about who he really is and the meaning of the baptisms that he is performing. His reply is "a voice that cries in the wilderness".

John was after coming out from the barren desert with an instruction to all to "make a straight way for the Lord".

In other words, he wanted his listeners to prepare for the coming of the Messiah. So, as we journey through this penitential season of Advent, we pray to the Lord to help us to prepare the way for the coming of Jesus into our lives by our words and our deeds.
