<u>SAINT OF THE WEEK - ST. PATRICK - PATRON SAINT OF IRELAND.</u>

Born in Britain probably in the early years of the fifth century, Patrick was taken captive at the age of 16 and brought to Ireland, where he worked as a slave. His captivity led him to a renewal of his spiritual life. After he escaped back home at the age of 22, it was clear to him that God was calling him to return to convert the Irish. After studies in Europe he returned to Ireland, where he made a very large number of converts. Places of pilgrimage like Lough Derg in Co. Donegal and Croagh Patrick in Co. Mayo are traditionally associated with him, as is the Celtic prayer, The Breastplate of St. Patrick. His feast day is celebrated on **17**th **March**.
