GOSPEL REFLECTION

In today's Gospel (Luke 1: 39-45) we hear the account of the Visitation of Mary to her cousin, Elizabeth. This event anticipates the birth of Jesus. Mary's journey to Elizabeth immediately followed the Annunciation of the Angel Gabriel to Mary, when she learned that she would give birth to the Messiah. She immediately heads off to see Elizabeth, who was in her sixth month of pregnancy with John the Baptist. This was a meeting like none other between two women who have been called by God to bring forth children into the world who would transform history. John the Baptist would lead the way for Jesus, who in turn would save us from our sins.

Elizabeth greets Mary with the words we say in the "Hail, Mary": "Blessed are you among women and blessed is the fruit of your womb." Elizabeth was expressing her faith that Jesus was the Messiah and she honoured Mary for her important role in bringing the Messiah into this world. God chose to become man in order to save us from our sins. But He did not force Himself into humanity. He did not disrespect our human freedom in order to do so. Rather, He invited Mary to be the mother of the Messiah. And because she said 'yes,' God became incarnate. Mary trusted God, even though what she was entrusted with what was beyond comprehension. Because of her great faith in welcoming Jesus into this world, we proclaim with Elizabeth that Mary is "blessed among women," and most of all, give thanks for the amazing gift of our Lord, Jesus, coming into this world.

As we approach the celebration of Christmas, we offer thanks to God for the greatest gift of all to the human race, His Son Jesus Christ. And, in celebrating Christmas, we should strive to focus our attention on Jesus, rather than the consumerism and commercialism of this time of year. Take time in prayer to give thanks for the blessings we have been given, especially the gift of salvation.

Prayer for the Week: Lord, I invite your peace to rule my heart! As I end this year and reflect on your many gifts you have given me; let my heart be encouraged with the truth that you are a good God. I thank you for sending your Son to die for me. I thank you for the peace I have through you. May my words and actions be ones that glorify you. Amen.
