Saint of the Week - St. Moninne of Killeavy

Moninne was born around 432 and is associated with the area of Slieve Gullion and the parish of Killeavy in South Armagh. She is said to have received the veil from St. Patrick and to have founded a community of eight virgins and a widow with a baby near Faughart, north Louth. She fostered the widow’s baby, Luger, & he later became a bishop. Moninne died around 518 and her feast day is celebrated on **6th July.**

3rd July 2022 – 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year C



In today's Gospel (Luke 10: 1-12 & 17-20), Jesus appoints 72 others to go ahead of Him to every town and place He plans to visit, proclaiming that the Kingdom of God is at hand. He sends them in pairs because at that time the law demanded that 2 witnesses were needed for a testimony to be credible. It was also a safer way to travel.

Jesus admits it will be difficult, that He is sending them out like "lamb among wolves." Yet they are to bring nothing with them, not even a money bag or sandals. They are to greet no one on the way so as not to be distracted from their mission. When they enter a house, they are to offer peace to all present. The response they will receive may be positive or negative. They are not to demand special treatment but eat and drink whatever is given them and to stay in the same house. They are to heal the sick as a sign that the Kingdom of God is at hand for them.

As in last week's Gospel, the theme of discipleship remains central. It has challenges, difficulties and rewards. Sharing in the mission of Jesus is not always easy, but everyone is called to do it, whether trained or not. The harvest is still plentiful. So, this week let us pray to the Lord of the harvest to continue to send out workers into the harvest and to help us to be welcoming to others and to spend time listening to and following His word.
