Norms for Indulgences at the Commemoration of All Souls

From twelve o'clock noon on 1st Nov until midnight on 2nd Nov all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the Pope's intentions (*one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice*) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th Nov. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this.

Please remember to bring in the November Lists of your dead. You will find a green and white envelope and a listing sheet for this purpose in your box of parish envelopes. You can drop them into the Offertory baskets during weekend and Holy Day Masses, or you can drop them into the metal boxes in the Church Porches. A number of Masses will be offered in each Church area during November for all those named on the lists.

A Prayer on All Saint's Day - 1st Nov

Dear Holy Saints of God, we join our prayers of praise to yours this day. With you, we sing of God's goodness, rejoice in God's mercy and celebrate God's incredible love. Teach us to live as you lived – always thinking of others, always recognising our weaknesses, always rejoicing in God's gifts, always closely following Jesus. Blessed are you, happy are you, all you holy saints of God. Pray for us that we too may someday be among God's Holy Ones. Amen.

Jesus, Our Lord and Saviour, on this day we prayerfully remember all our loved ones who have died. Gospel Reflection

Luke 19: 1-10

In today's Gospel, we hear about Zacchaeus, a wealthy man of small stature and dishonest ways. He heard about Jesus travelling through Jericho and he wanted to get a look at Him but was unable see over the crowds. So, he ran ahead of the crowd and climbed a sycamore tree to get a good viewing point but when Jesus saw Zacchaeus, he called him down from the tree and told him that he must stay in his house that night.

This was a life changing moment for Zacchaeus who welcomed Jesus and was overjoyed. When the crowd voiced their disapproval of Jesus staying in a sinner's house, Zacchaeus promised to give half his property to the poor and return money fourfold to those he cheated.

This Gospel teaches us that no one is beyond the reach of God's grace. Every soul is very dear to Him. There are many people in today's world who are searching for Jesus just like Zacchaeus and are not sure where or how to find Him. Jesus is everywhere. He invites Himself into our homes and into our hearts. In our hearts all love is born and from our hearts love grows and spreads. The willingness of Zacchaeus to welcome Jesus to his home was not done out of fear but out of love. Jesus never abandons hope in anyone, and His mercy will always be greater than our poor human limitations. Despite our unworthiness, God calls us, forgives us and nurtures us to spiritual well-being. Let's us therefore turn to Jesus and invite Him into our hearts and surrender all we have to Him.
