G O S P E L R E F L E C T I O N

In today's Gospel (Matt. 1: 18-24) we hear about how Jesus came to be born. The Virgin Mary was engaged to Joseph, the carpenter from Nazareth, but before they were married, Mary was found to be with child by the intercession of the Holy Spirit. This all made no sense to Joseph who was a man of honour, so he decided to quietly break off the engagement with Mary and remove himself from the situation. However, before doing so he had a dream during which an angel of the Lord appeared to him and asked that he take Mary as his wife and that she would give birth to a baby boy. This baby was to be called Jesus and would be the one to save his people from their sins. On waking from his dream, Joseph does as the angel of the Lord directs. He takes Mary to be his wife and accepts the child as his own.

Joseph and Mary both cooperate fully with God's plan and are models for us of what it means to be faithful servants of God. They are not asked to do it all alone by themselves as they are assured that God will be with them. Similarly, God is always with us too giving us the strength and the courage to follow the example of Mary and Joseph. They heard and listened to God's words, and we too are asked to open our hearts and our lives to God. Through our daily lives, through what we say and do, may we say YES to God's call just as Mary and Joseph did, so that God will become flesh and live among us this Christmas.

A Prayer for Joy during the Fourth Week of Advent: O God, our Creator, our world is loaded with anticipation of the birth of Your Son. We are bursting in preparedness for the Feast of Christmas which will soon be upon us. Help us to find a quiet moment to reflect on and appreciate the Word who is coming to dwell with us. Help us to hope in the promise of His Way, His Truth and His Life. Help us to join with the angels who sing Your praise and grant us the lasting peace of this great season of Joy. We make this prayer in the name of our long-expected Lord. Amen.
