This program is an opportunity for people to gather together to pray, share and reflect on the Sunday Gospels during Lent. Lent is a good time for people to nourish their spiritual life. In this program "Lectio Divina" we place the word of God at the Centre of our prayer life, as we try and deepen our relationship with Christ and each other.



One of the great masters in prayer said: "the word comes to us in *Reading* to awaken the heart". This is at the centre of *lectio divina* (*divine reading*). This technique in prayer is a guide to living, it means going into our heart to find God. I am a priest for quite a few years now and it has taken me a long time to learn that coming face to face with the sacred text is what really matters, reading the scripture is essential.

Our first meeting takes place in the Tom Clarke Memorial rooms, Carrigallen on Tue next 21<sup>st</sup> Feb 8:30pm-9:30pm. It will just last one hour.

# Gospel Reflection

Matt 5: 38-48

In today's Gospel Jesus tells his disciples not to live in accordance with what they have heard in the past (the old law): "an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth; love your neighbour and hate your enemy". With Jesus, that is the earthly way of living, but which is not the way the children of God are called to follow. Rather, Jesus tells us to love our enemies and pray for those who persecute us, so that we may be children of our Father in heaven. In other words, Jesus is telling us that our enemies and those who persecute us are those who are most in need of our love and our prayers.

Jesus distinguishes between earthly rewards and rewards from God. If we love those who love us, our reward is an increase in their love. However, if we love those who hate us, our reward is an increase in God's love. For Jesus, we must love one another, and exclude no one from our love. We know that there is much evil in the world in which we live today but we are asked not to let it force us to fight it with revenge and hatred. It is not good to fight war with war. Instead, we should fight it with our God-given weapons of mercy, forgiveness and love for the ones who have hurt us.
