# **Parish Newsletter**

Palm Sunday— 2nd April 2023 Year A

### HOLY WEEK

Today, Palm/Passion Sunday is the first day of Holy Week. It is the day that we remember and celebrate the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem on the back of a borrowed donkey as Saviour and King. A large crowd gathered and laid palm branches and their cloaks across the road, giving Him royal treatment while singing Hosanna in the Highest. Ironically it was the same crowd who would shout "Crucify Him" a few days later.

On Spy Wednesday, Jesus and His disciples prepared for Passover. The term "Spy" refers to Judas Iscariot and how he betrayed our Lord to the religious leader in exchange for thirty silver coins.

Holy Thursday is the first day of the Triduum and the day when
Jesus washed the feet of His disciples in an extraordinary display of humility.
At Jesus' final meal (The Last Supper) before his death, He ordained
His Apostles as the first priests and instituted the Eucharist, finishing
with the words, "Do this in Memory of Me."

Good Friday celebrates what we as Christians believe to be the most solemn day of the Liturgical year. Ever since Jesus died and was raised, Christians have proclaimed the cross and resurrection of Jesus to be the decisive turning point for all creation. This is the day Jesus willingly suffered and died by crucifixion as the ultimate sacrifice for our sins.

Holy Saturday is the last day of Lent and is a time of reflection and waiting. On this day Pontius Pilate instructed guards to be posted at the tomb to prevent Jesus' followers from removing the body to claim that he had risen from the dead. This day ends with the Easter Vigil, the lighting of the Paschal Candle, the blessing of the Easter Water and the renewal of Baptismal Vows.

Easter Sunday is the celebration of Christ's resurrection from the dead and marks the end of Holy Week. The Resurrection marks the triumph of good over evil, sin and death. It is the singular event which proves that those who trust in God and accept Christ, will be raised from the dead.

Easter represents the fulfilment of God's promises to mankind and is the most important holiday on the Christian calendar.
