

## One Bread, One Body

Today we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ. We are reminded that Jesus is indeed the true Bread of Life. This is a joyful celebration of the permanent presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Devotion to the Blessed Sacrament flows from the heart of the Mass and the Holy Communion into which we enter in receiving Christ in the Eucharist. The Mass is the re-presentation of what Jesus did on the night



before he died, the first Holy Thursday. During the Last Supper he took bread and wine, blessed and broken, and gave it to His disciples saying, "This is My Body, This is My Blood, given for you". In those words and actions, in that sacred moment of giving, Jesus pre-figured the greatest action of all – the offering of Himself for us on the Cross. This sacred action is repeated during the consecration at every Mass we attend when the bread and wine are transformed into the Body and Blood of Christ. Eucharist is the place where we are always welcomed by the Lord. Eucharist is where the word of hope that is the Reign of God is shared with us. Eucharist is where we gather in our brokenness for healing. The Eucharist is an expression of God's ultimate and bountiful generosity for which we should be eternally grateful. It is given freely out of love to each of us and may we never take it for granted. Because we have shared in the Eucharist with each other, we are also called by Jesus to care for and serve each other. As we celebrate this feast day in memory of Jesus, may we also serve each other in His memory too.


