GOSPEL REFLECTION

In today's Gospel (Matt. 11: 25-30) Jesus first prays in thanksgiving to God who is Lord of heaven and earth and who has made himself known to Jesus' disciples. He praises God who has made himself known to "mere children" and not to the wise and learned. God has made himself known through Jesus, and in knowing Jesus, we come to know the Father. In Jesus' life and in his person, God reveals himself to us. "No one knows the Father except the Son and no one knows the Son except the Father."

Jesus invites us to find rest and solace in Him and affirms that He is always there to comfort and support us. When we are tired or finding things difficult, we can turn to Him and find rest. He acknowledges the burdens we carry and the struggles we face, and He offers to share and lighten our load. The demands of God are not beyond our strength. To follow Jesus places a burden on us, but it is a lighter burden than what we would carry if we did not follow Him. His way of holiness is uncomplicated and restful.

Prayer for the Week: God of all, be with us when we find things hard. Strengthen us as we help each other, so that all people may have hope for the future. Amen.
