# Gospel Reflection (Matt.16:13-20)

In today's Gospel Jesus took some of his closest disciples to the remote region of Caesarea Philippi to have an important conversation with them. Firstly, He asked them about who do the people think the Son of Man really is, and they tell Him that He is viewed as a great prophet, similar to John the Baptist, Elijah or Jeremiah. He then asked them to share their own opinion about Him. Peter responded on behalf of the group by telling Jesus that He is the Christ, the Son of the living God. Jesus agreed with this statement and explained that Peter did not give this answer based on his own knowledge but by the revelation of God.

Following this, Jesus proclaims that Peter is the rock on which the Church of God will be built and that the keys of the kingdom will also be given to Peter. Thus, the Church was established and Peter became the first Pope and second in command to Jesus. From Peter down to Pope Francis today, there has been an unbroken line of popes who have led the Church under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. Based on Jesus' promise, they have the authority to bind and to loose which means that they have authority over the Church in matters of teaching, membership, morals, etc. Throughout Church history, Jesus has remained faithful to His promise

that the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it.

So, this week, if you are asked the question – who do you say that Jesus is?—would you have an appropriate answer and are you helping to continue the work of the Church started by Peter two thousand years ago?

**Prayer for the week:** Living God, you sent your Son among us to reveal Your wisdom and make known Your ways. Increase our faith, that we may confess Jesus as your Son, take up his work on earth, and trust his promise to sustain the Church. Through Christ, Our Lord.. Amen.
