Gospel Reflection (MATT.14:22-33)

In today's Gospel, Jesus heads for the hills to find some quiet time for prayer after sending his disciples ahead of him by boat to the other side of the lake. By evening time, the waters become choppy and the disciples struggle to weather the wind and waves, making little progress in their journey. However, they are not fearful, at least not until they see Jesus walking towards them on the water thinking that they are seeing a ghost. Jesus then calls to them and calms their fears. He is not a ghost, but Peter seeks proof that the person is indeed Jesus, so he asks Jesus to call him out onto the water, and Jesus grants this request. Peter's fears and doubts then overtake him, but Jesus reaches out to him and saves him. When they both get back into the boat, the wind ceases, and the disciples acknowledge that Jesus is truly the Son of God.

Walking on water is not something we should aspire to, but there's much more that we can do which at first might seem to be impossible or frighten us like upskilling or stepping out of our comfort zone and into the unfamiliar. Faith in Jesus enabled the disciples to do the work that was previously done by Him and similarly our faith and our trust in God will help us navigate through life's difficulties. Of course, we are also expected to reach out our hands to others who may be over-anxious and finding life very challenging. So, this week, if we encounter any stormy waters as we sail along on the boat of life, let us place all our faith and trust in Jesus lest we sink beneath the waves and also hold out a helping hand to others who are in need.

Prayer for the week: Lord, save us when circumstances seem to overwhelm us, when we cannot see our way forward, when we find ourselves sinking. Take us by the hand and lead us to the open space of freedom and confidence in you. Amen.
