## Gospel Reflection (MATT.17:1-9)

In today's gospel, we hear about the miracle of the Transfiguration of Jesus. Firstly, He brings three of His disciples, Peter, James and John up a high mountain where they can be alone. Then suddenly His appearance totally changes as His face and clothes shine brightly like the sun. Moses and Elijah representing the Law and the Prophets from the Old Testament appear too. Peter who wanted the moment to last, suggested building three tents but immediately a voice came from a bright cloud saying: "This is my Son, the Beloved, listen to Him." The disciples were full of fear, but Jesus uses His familiar phrase, "do not be afraid." Normality returns and they descend the mountain while been told by Jesus not to tell anyone about the vision until after the Resurrection.

The disciple's lives were changed forever by the events on the mountain. They now know how special Jesus is and that He is the Son of God. Our lives too can be changed by Jesus who lives in all of us. But we have to listen to and trust in Him. He will show us how to live our lives and to do what is right, to stand up for our faith and to help those in need. As the disciples were at first confused by what happened on the mountain, we too can be confused at times in our lives when we experience change and uncertainty but as Christians, we believe that through our faith we can be transfigured into a new life with the Lord.

**The Transfiguration Prayer:** Transfiguring God, before the passion of your beloved Son you revealed his glory on the holy mountain: grant that we who by faith behold the light of his face may be strengthened to bear the cross and be changed into his likeness from glory to glory; through the same Jesus Christ who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God forever and ever. Amen.
