## GOSPEL REFLECTION (Matt. 21: 28-32)

In today's Gospel we focus on a father, his two sons and a vineyard where there is work to be done. Now the father asks his first son to go and work in the vineyard, but the son says no. However, on reflection, he went and did the work. The father then asks the second son to do the work and the answer is a very positive yes but he doesn't do any work. Then Jesus puts asks the chief priests/elders/pharisees about which son did the father's will and the unanimous answer was son number one as actions speak louder than words. But Jesus rebukes them by telling them that they did not respond positively to the message of repentance preached by John the Baptist. Accordingly, many of the less respected and more sinful members of the community who heeded the words of John the Baptist would reach the Kingdom of God ahead of the religious leaders.

We all know people in society and even in our own families who resemble the two sons in the Gospel. Some say yes to a request but the yes soon becomes a false promise while others initially say no but later, maybe out of guilt, will actually half heartily act upon the request. What Jesus asks of us is a full commitment, both words and actions, to any task we take on. The more we put our heart and soul into a project, the greater will be the reward and the satisfaction. And regarding vineyards, remember that God is our Master and we are merely guests in His vineyard.

**Prayer for the Week**: Merciful Father, you are our help and our strength. Open our hearts to your grace that we may always know, and do, your will. We ask this through Christ our Lord. **Amen.**
