World Mission Sunday 2023

World Mission Sunday is the Holy Father's annual appeal for spiritual and financial support so that the life-giving work of overseas missionaries can continue. Collections take place in every single parish where the Church is present. This includes not only Ireland and Europe, but also in poorer parishes in developing countries. It is a moment of universal solidarity when each member of the Church family, regardless of location or background, play their part in supporting each other.
