WORLD DAY OF THE POOR

GOSPEL REFLECTION

(Matt. 25: 14-30)

In today's Gospel we hear the "Parable of the Talents." The man going on his travels represents God while the servants represent His people. In the time of Jesus, the word "talents" had a different meaning than that of today. They were large valuable coins. The master entrusts his money to the care of his servants while abroad. He is expecting them to take good care of his resources, not squandering and also not simply sitting on it and doing nothing. The first two servants, entrusted with the most money, invest it and double the money the master gave to them. But the third servant, out of fear of the master, did nothing with the money. He was lazy and buried it, not working to grow what was given to him. As a result, the master punished him and gave his original talent to the one who started off with five.

This parable tells us what we are to do with the "talents" God has given us. In reality, everything we have, has been given to us by God. We are His servants who are called to use what He has given to us for the greater good. This parable is really a call to faithful stewardship. God wants us to bear good fruit with the time and talents given to us. Then, as a result of our faithfulness, He will reward us. So, this week let us reflect on the many gifts and talents given to us by God. How can we make best use of them and also think of the many blessings we have, thank God for them, and strive to offer them back to Him for His glory.

WORLD DAY OF THE POOR: We are all called to join Pope Francis in celebrating the seventh World Day of the Poor today, 19th Nov. 2023 (33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time). The theme of this year's message is "Do not turn your face away from anyone who is poor", taken from the Book of Tobit, that offers a rich teaching on poverty and charity. The World Day of the Poor is an opportunity for the Church community to show its solidarity with the poorest of our sisters and brothers, both at home and abroad.
