GOSPEL REFLECTION

In today's Gospel (John 1: 6-8 & 19-28) we hear again about the comi John the Baptist and his announcement of the coming of the Messiah, Jesus Christ. The "light" mentioned in the beginning of the Gospel refers to Jesus, the eternal Word of God. We are told that John is not the Messiah but came to prepare the way for Jesus. People were not very sure about who John really was. He was creating a bit of a stir by his preaching and baptizing. The Jews were expecting the Messiah to come, so they wondered if John might be him. So, they sent priests and Levites to question him about his identity and John makes it clear that he is not the Messiah. Furthermore, with the coming of the Messiah, the Jews were anticipating the return of the great Prophet Elijah. But John makes clear he is not him either. Nor is he "the Prophet," who was expected. Finally, John tells them that he is the forerunner to the Messiah, a voice that cries in the wilderness. But he did not want in any way to take away attention from Jesus. He was not the focus.

Rather, his role was to help the people be ready for the Messiah. John was then questioned further as to why he was baptising people in the river Jordan if he was not the Messiah. His reply was that he baptised only with water but there was already one in their midst who was coming after him, one who he would not even be fit to untie his sandal-strap for him. The true identity of Jesus would not be revealed until his baptism by John which would mark the start of his public ministry. John acknowledged the greatness of Jesus and announced his coming, calling the people to repent so their hearts would be ready to encounter God in the flesh. In a similar way, we are called to prepare our hearts during Advent through repentance as we prepare to encounter Christ at Christmas.

On this, the third Sunday of Advent we light the pink or rose coloured candle on the Advent Wreath which symbolizes rejoicing. During this week we are filled with joy for the near arrival of Jesus on Christmas Day. This Sunday is often called 'Gaudete Sunday' as we reflect on the joy the shepherd's felt at the birth of Jesus.
