The famous Cistercian monk Thomas Merton put it so well, "our job is to love others without stopping to ask whether or not they are worthy". That is the first task of every family, the little family in which we grow up in or in the larger family of the church to which we belong.

A blessing for the New Year: "May the Lord bless you and keep you. May the Lord let his face shine on you and be gracious to you. May the Lord uncover his face to you and bring you peace". May this be yours in the coming year.


