GOSPEL REFLECTION (Mark 1: 12-15)

On this, the First Sunday of Lent we begin a time of reflection on our lives. Jesus did this by heading off to the wilderness or the desert for a period of forty days and forty nights. His journey was guided by the Holy Spirit and He was minded by the angels. The figure forty is also mentioned in the Old Testament as it was the number of years spent wandering by the Israelites in the desert after being led from slavery in Egypt. The prophet Elijah also journeyed for forty days and forty nights through the desert on his way to Horeb. Remembering the significance of these events, we also set aside 40 days for the season of Lent.

Today's Gospel also marks the beginning of Jesus' battle with Satan; the ultimate test will be in Jesus' final hours on the cross. In a similar

way, our Lenten observances are a preparation for and a reinforcement of our ongoing struggle to resist the temptations we face in our everyday lives. During Lent, we too are led by the Holy Spirit to remember the vows of Baptism in which we promised to reject sin and to follow Jesus. Just as Jesus was ministered to by the angels, God also supports us in our struggle against sin and temptation. We succeed because Jesus conquered sin once and for all in His saving death on the cross.

A Prayer at the Beginning of Lent: God of goodness and mercy, hear my prayer as I begin this Lenten journey with You. Let me be honest with myself as I look into my heart and soul, noticing the times I turn away from You. Guide me as I humbly seek to repent and return to Your love. May humility guide my efforts to be reconciled with you and live forever in your abundant grace. Transform me this Lent, heavenly Father. Give me the strength to commit myself to grow closer to You each day. Amen.
