GOSPEL REFLECTION

(Mark 9: 2-10)

In today's Gospel Jesus brings His friends and disciples, Peter, James and John up Mount Tabor. While there, a sudden and transformative change comes over Jesus. His clothes become dazzlingly white, and the prophets Elijah and Moses appeared and started talking to Jesus. The disciples were a bit frightened and overwhelmed by these happenings. Peter who wasn't sure about what to do, asked Jesus about building three tents. Then, in an instant, a cloud appeared and a voice from the cloud was heard saying "This is my Son, the Beloved. Listen to Him". Then normality was restored, and Jesus and His Disciples descend the mountain. While on their way down He tells them not to tell anyone about what they seen until after His Resurrection.

The Transfiguration was a very special and memorable moment in the Apostles lives. For us, Lent can be a good time to remember special times in our lives too and to draw strength from them. It can also be a good time to climb a high hill and see the world and our lives more clearly, away from the noise and busyness of our everyday lives. There, without distraction, we can listen to Jesus as He leads us on our Lenten journey towards Easter.

Prayer for the Week: Dear Lord, Son of God, You grew up among the hills of Gallilee. Lift us up so that we may see further. Strengthen our faith that we may see beyond the horizon. And when the valley closes us in, help us to remember the view from the hilltop. Amen.
