HOLY WEEK

Today, Palm/Passion Sunday, we remember the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem on the back of a borrowed donkey as Saviour and King. A large crowd gathered and laid palm branches and their cloaks across the road, giving Him royal treatment while singing "Hosanna in the Highest". Ironically it was the same crowd who would shout "Crucify Him" a few days later.

On **Spy Wednesday**, Jesus and His disciples prepared for Passover. The term "Spy" refers to Judas Iscariot and how he betrayed our Lord to the religious leader in exchange for thirty silver coins.

On **Holy Thursday**, we celebrate the Lord's Supper, where Jesus instituted the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist and the priesthood. Jesus gave his disciples a new commandment to love one another as He loved them, washing their feet as a sign of service and humility.

On **Good Friday**, the Church remembers the Passion and death of Jesus Christ, where He suffered and died on the cross for the salvation of humanity. Today we fast and abstain from meat. The liturgy of the day includes the reading of the Passion of Christ and the Veneration of the Cross.

Holy Saturday is a day of silence and reflection, where the Church waits in anticipation of Christ's Resurrection. The Easter Vigil is the most significant liturgy of the year, celebrating Christ's victory over sin and death, through the lighting of the Paschal candle.

Easter Sunday is the day we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ, the triumph of life over death. This day is marked by joyous celebrations, with the proclamation of the Easter Gospel and singing hymns of praise.

I await the new life with eagerness, faith and a deep gratitude. Amen.
