# OUR LADY OF FATIMA

On Monday, 13<sup>th</sup> May we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima, looking to the Blessed Mother for peace and comfort in times of uncertainty. According to tradition, on 13<sup>th</sup> May 1917, the Virgin Mary appeared to 3 shepherd children, Lúcia dos Santos, Francisco Marto, and Jacinta Marto, near Fatima, Portugal. The children saw her five more times in the months that followed, and she asked them to pray the Rosary daily and give devotion to her Immaculate Heart. During the last sighting, she told the children her name was *The Lady of the Rosary* and gave them a message of prayer, peace, and penance known as the "Secret."

That same year, in what later became known as the Miracle of the Sun, on  $13^{th}$  October 1917, throngs of the faithful who gathered in Fatima reported seeing the sun dance in the sky. This joyous miraculous event continues to bring hope to the faithful around the world. Today, Fatima continues to be a beacon of comforting hope but also a strong appeal for conversion. The light that Mary made shine into the eyes of the shepherd children and manifested to so many people in the Miracle of the Sun on  $13^{th}$  October, shows that God's grace is stronger than sin and death.

**PRAYER**: Our Lady of Fatima, today we pray for your Son to come to our aid and end the suffering and wars throughout the world. Help us to be like the children at Fatima; loving, trusting and faithful. May we pray to bring peace to our own world in our own small way by choosing to love and trust in the Lord. Amen.
