OUR JOURNEY THROUGH HOLY WEEK

Palm (Passion) Sunday: We start Holy Week by commemorating Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. Palm branches are blessed symbolizing the palms spread before Jesus as He entered the City. "Hosanna in the Highest."

Holy Mon. / Holy Tues: These are the quieter days of Holy Week. Despite being aware of His upcoming fate, Jesus continues as normal with His teaching/preaching ministry in Jerusalem.

Spy Wednesday: Things begin to change. Preparations for the Passover begin. We hear about how Judas Iscariot betrays Jesus for thirty silver coins. Chrism Masses are held in each Diocese. Holy Oils are blessed.

Holy Thursday: Also known as Maundy Thursday, we commemorate the Last Supper Jesus shared with His disciples. It introduces two new Sacraments - the Eucharist and the Priesthood. The washing of the feet re-enacts Jesus' act of service to love one another. The Eucharist is transferred to the Altar of Repose, symbolizing Jesus' agony in Gethsemane. "Do this in memory of me."

Good Friday: This is the only day in the Liturgical calendar without a Mass. Instead, a solemn service commemorates Jesus' crucifixion and death. The veneration of the cross, a central part of the service, allows the faithful to show reverence for the instrument of our salvation. It's a day of fasting and penance, reflecting on the suffering and death of Jesus. "Forgive them for they know not what they do." "Jesus remember me when You come into your Kingdom."

Holy Saturday: A day of quiet reflection, waiting at the tomb of Jesus. The Church meditates on Jesus' descent into the dead, proclaiming the good news to the souls in limbo. After nightfall, the Easter Vigil starts with the blessing of the fire and lighting the Paschal Candle. We hear the Exsultet (Easter Proclamation) & readings from the Old and New Testaments. New members are welcomed into the Church through Baptism and we renew our Baptismal Promises. Easter Sunday: Today we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. Masses are joyful, reflecting the triumph over sin and death. It's a day of celebration, feasting, and gratitude for the new life offered through Jesus' resurrection. "He is Risen, our King of Glory." ALLELUIA.
