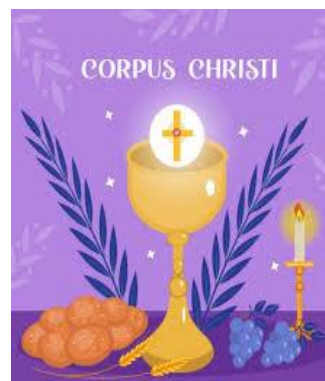

07th June 2026 – Feast of Corpus Christi - Year A



The Feast of Corpus Christi invites Christians to contemplate one of the deepest mysteries of the faith: the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. We turn our attention to the gift Jesus left at the Last Supper, not merely a symbol or remembrance, but His very Body and Blood given for the life of the world. We are also reminded that communion with Christ leads to communion with one another. We cannot receive the Bread of Life and remain indifferent to the

needs of others. The Eucharist nourishes us so that we may become what we receive. Through acts of charity and forgiveness we carry Christ's presence beyond the church walls and into our homes, workplaces and communities.

As we celebrate Corpus Christi, we might ask ourselves: Do I approach the Eucharist with gratitude and reverence? Do I allow Christ's presence to shape the way I live and treat others? Am I willing to become a sign of His love in the world?
