## SENDING OUT THE TWELVE



In today's Gospel (Matt. 9:36; 10:8) Jesus is sending out the Twelve Apostles on their mission. (12 Symbolizes the 12 Tribes of Israel). He did not wait until they were perfect or free from fear.

He just entrusted them with a mission and sent

them ahead carrying little except faith and the authority He had given them. Their journey reminds us that God often works through willing hearts rather than impressive qualifications. The Twelve were sent not merely to speak but to serve, heal, encourage & bring hope. Their mission was both practical & spiritual. The good news was meant to be seen in acts of compassion as much as heard in words. Do our lives truly reflect the message we proclaim ?

Jesus also prepared them for rejection. Not every town would welcome them, and not every person would listen. Yet their responsibility was faithfulness, not success. This is a comforting reminder that we are called to witness with love and integrity, leaving the results in God's hands. The sending out of the Twelve continues to speak to believers today. We are invited to step beyond comfort, trust God's guidance, serve others generously and share hope wherever we are placed. The mission begins not with extraordinary ability but with a willingness to go where Christ sends us and to trust that His presence goes with us.

**PRAYER:** Lord, as you sent out the Twelve, send me into my daily life with courage and compassion. Teach me to trust your provision, serve others faithfully, and share your love with humility. Help me not to be discouraged by difficulties or rejection, but to remain steadfast in the work you have given me. Amen.
